

CADDIE BRAIN

Kedleston Park Golf Club

Derby, England · Par 72 · 18 holes (White tees)

Built for: 6 handicap · driver 320y carry · 7-iron 195y · slight draw · one-way miss · short game rated 2/5.

Par and yardage (white tees) come from GolfCourseAPI, cross-checked against this course's own previously-verified hole 10 yardage (375y) -- an exact match. Stroke index comes from this course's OpenStreetMap routing data; hole 11's tag was missing there, but every other index 1-18 was present exactly once, so 11 is the one left over, not a guess. Tee and green positions are calculated precisely from that same real routing data, and every hole page is a real aerial photograph (Esri World Imagery), fetched and cropped to that hole. Every tee shot is drawn as a full set of arcs, one per club in your bag, each struck from the real tee at that club's actual carry-plus-roll distance -- your whole yardage book laid over a real photograph of the ground. No club is picked out for you; every arc is drawn the same way and the choice is yours.

THE HOLE

A tree-lined opening hole, par 5.



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EXPECT

A layup or a long second, depending on the tee shot.

MISS

Trees line both sides of the fairway -- the main defence here is the corridor width, not one specific hazard.

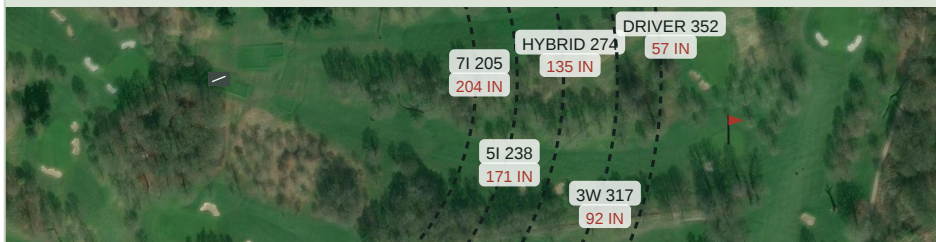

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EXPECT

A long second into the green.

MISS

A narrow, tree-lined corridor most of the way -- index 2 for a reason.

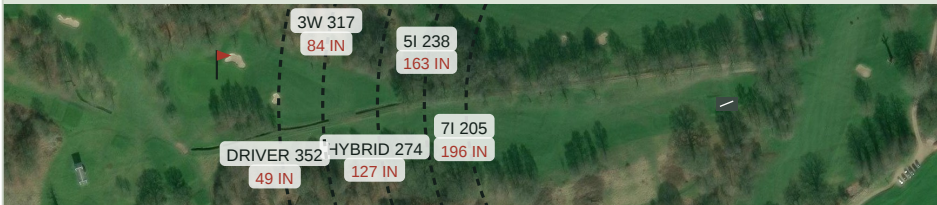

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EXPECT

A mid-to-long iron in.

MISS

Trees frame the fairway on both sides; nothing else stands out in the real photo.

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EXPECT

A two-putt.

MISS

A bunker sits close to the green -- otherwise the easiest of the four par 3s here.

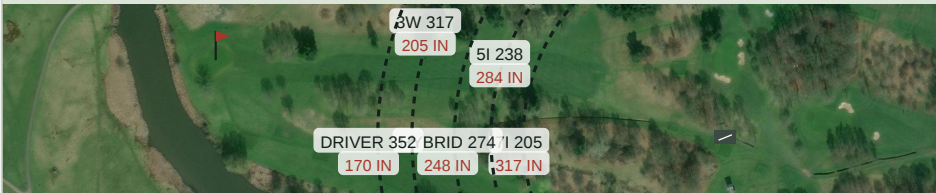

The longest hole on the card, with water running along the left.



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EXPECT

A three-shot hole for most.

MISS

The river that borders several holes on this stretch of the course tracks the left side of the fairway here too.

WHY

This and the next two holes all run alongside the same water feature -- worth knowing before picking a line on any of them.

THE HOLE

The river from the previous hole runs right by this green.



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EXPECT

A long second into a green close to the water.

MISS

The same water feature borders the green here -- visible clearly in the real photo, right at the putting surface.

A full water carry to a green tucked beside a bunker.



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EXPECT

A two-putt.

MISS

The pond fills most of the frame between tee and green, and there's a bunker right at the putting surface too -- the third and last hole on this water feature.

The card's easiest hole -- short, tree-lined, a pond off to the side.



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EXPECT

A short iron in.

MISS

Lowest stroke index on the course; trees are the main defence at this length, with a pond visible off the direct line.

A tree-lined par 4 back toward the clubhouse turn.



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EXPECT

A mid-to-long iron in.

MISS

Trees line the corridor most of the way to the green.

A dogleg with water left of the green and bunkers right.



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EXPECT

A mid-iron in.

MISS

Water sits left of the green, two bunkers sit right of it, and there's thick rough behind -- not much margin long.

WHY

The most thoroughly mapped hole in this guide: real OSM geometry, cross-checked against a published course description, confirmed the water-left/bunkers-right layout independently.

THE HOLE

A tree-lined par 3, the longest of the four.



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EXPECT

A two-putt.

MISS

Trees frame the green on both sides; no standout hazard beyond the length itself in the real photo.

The hardest hole on the card -- bunkers flank the green on both sides.



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EXPECT

A long second into a well-guarded green.

MISS

Index 1: it's long, and bunkers show up on both sides of the fairway up by the green.

One of the easier holes on the card, with bunkers scattered around the green.



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EXPECT

A layup or a long second.

MISS

A few bunkers sit around the green; a pond off to the side looks to be out of the direct line.

A bunker sits left, roughly mid-fairway.



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EXPECT

A mid-iron in.

MISS

A bunker on the left is the main hazard visible in the real photo here.

A tight, tree-lined corridor -- index 3.



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EXPECT

A long second into a tucked-away green.

MISS

Trees press in on both sides for most of the hole, with a bunker showing up near the green.

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EXPECT

A two-putt.

MISS

At least two bunkers sit right at the putting surface in the real photo.

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EXPECT

A three-shot hole for most.

MISS

Water shows up on the left side of the frame near the tee, though the direct line looks clear of it.

The finishing hole, back by the clubhouse -- bunkers along the way.



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EXPECT

A mid-iron in to close the card.

MISS

Bunkers show up along the fairway on the approach to the green, with the clubhouse visible close by.
